Children's House Supplies and Student Fees

Supplies

Please bring the supplies listed below to orientation or send with your child the first day of school.

Please label everything that can become detached from your child!

Please send these items to be kept at school:

- ◇ A pair of shoes used as *indoor* shoes
- ◇ A complete set of labeled clothing: pants, shirt, socks, underwear, a sweater or sweatshirt in a zip lock bag
- ◇ Five plain colored folders (no characters) for papers/notes traveling to and from school
- ◇ A 4x6" family photo to display in the class photo album
- ◇ Small water bottle
- ◇ Chap stick as needed
- ◇ *Optional:* A small non-poisonous plant for the children to care for this year. (please do not write your child's name on the plant)
- ◇ 1 box of tissues
- ◇ 1 box crackers (any variety)
- ◇ 3 watercolor paints (8 colors only)
- ◇ 1 pk sponges (multi-color)
- ◇ Brush or comb (optional)
- ◇ 10 pk Ticonderoga pencils (not mechanical, no characters please)
- ◇ 3 glue sticks

During the school year also send a **Nutritious lunch**, if child is attending full-day and bringing lunch from home.

Fees can be paid at Woodland Welcome Day or in the Woodland office during the first week of school.

Certain standard fees are paid by all BASD students and are collected at the beginning of each school year:

- Materials Fee: \$5.00
- Milk fee for snack (approximate price): \$5/Month or \$45/Year
- Lunch: \$1.95/Day

Montessori specific fees

In the Children's House, practical life activities are used daily and are important for gaining skills necessary for future work in other areas, such as the refinement of fine motor control needed to use a pencil. Most of the practical life activities include food items to be washed, peeled, and cut. To ensure a reliable supply for children to be able to do this important work, we ask that you either:

- Pay \$50 for one child/\$75 for two or more children
- OR
- Be willing to provide groceries from a list your child will bring home twice throughout the year

(We are offering this option as a request from parents; some enjoy shopping for the items while others would rather pay a onetime fee).
